
One Owner




Funded by money he/she can raise.

Produces a small amount of cars




Partnership




Funded with twice the money

Shares the profit and shares all loses if no profit gained.


Owns more than one factory




Employs more workers to operate machines on multiple assembly lines.

Corporation (Original owner(s) and shareholders)




Funded by the sale of stock or shares in the company.

Gets their share of profit (Amount of stock) and loses only in the price of their stock.


Share/Stock holders
